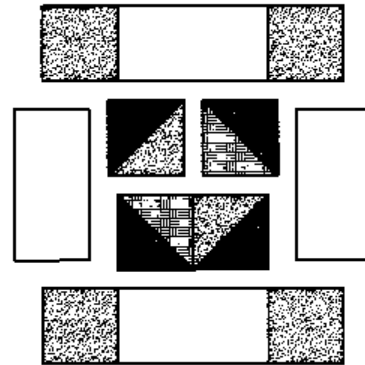
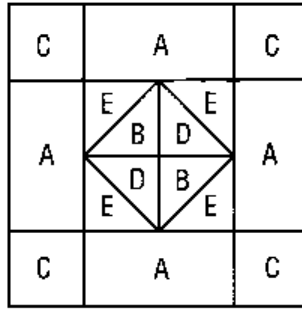
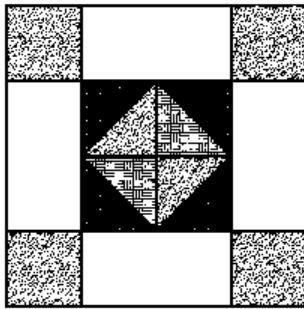


## February Block of the Month

### Fair and Square for NSQ

Block size finished: 12" square



All measurements include  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.

Kit contains:

A: 4 -  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles

B: 1 - 4" square

C: 4 -  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

D: 1 - 4" square

E: 2 - 4" squares

\*Please take the time to measure all the pieces to know where they will be used in this block. I plan to reverse the light and dark in every other block.

Directions:

First you will make half-square triangle squares; using B-square and 1-E square and D square and the last E square. Draw a line diagonally on the back of the B and D squares (cutting line). Then draw 2 more lines, one on each side,  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away (sewing line). Once you have sewn on the lines (I sew just inside the sewing line), you will cut on the first line. Then press toward the dark, take over to cutting mat and trim down to  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square using the 45\* angle on the ruler down the center of the square. Now lie out the pieces as shown above and sew the 4 half-square triangle squares together (they will measure  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " square). Then add the A-  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle on each side, press away from the center (now this will measure  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $12\frac{1}{2}$ "); add the 4-C squares to the ends of the remaining A rectangles, press toward the rectangle, (they will measure  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $12\frac{1}{2}$ " each). Now sew them to the top and bottom of the center and press, the block will measure  $12\frac{1}{2}$ " square unfinished. Congratulations you have completed your block for the month of February.
