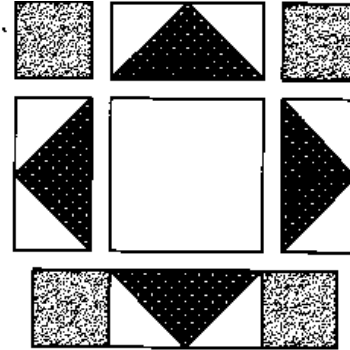
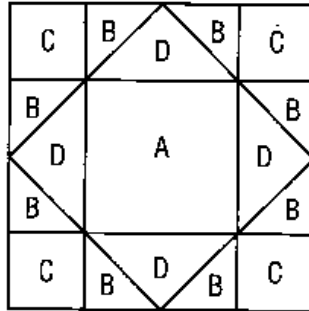
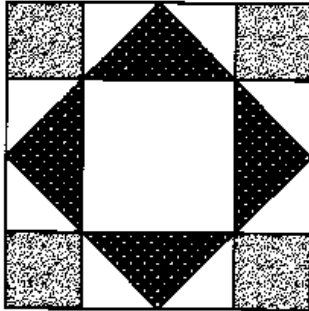


January Block of the Month King's Crown for NSQ

Block size finished: 12" square



All measurement include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.

Kits contain:

A: 1 - $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " square

B: 4 - $3 \frac{7}{8}$ " squares

C: 4 - $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares

D: 1 - $7 \frac{1}{4}$ " square (cut twice on the diagonal)

*Please measure the squares to make sure you know which squares I'm telling you to use, because I've reversed the mediums and darks in every other block.

Directions:

First you will cut the D-square twice on the diagonal for 4-triangles and the B-squares once on the diagonal for 8-triangles. Sew the B-triangles to the D-triangles to make 4-B-D unit's that will measure $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles. Now lie out the pieces as shown above to create the block. You will sew 2 of the B-D unit's to the center square and press toward the center. The center unit will now measure $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $12 \frac{1}{2}$ "; now sew the C-squares to the ends of the remaining B-D units. Press toward the C-squares and these units will measure $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $12 \frac{1}{2}$ " and as shown above they will be sewn onto the top and bottom of the center unit, press and measure the block as it should be $12 \frac{1}{2}$ " square. Congratulations, you have completed the January block. Now put it with the bag to bring back to the next meeting. See you next month. THANK YOU!!!!
