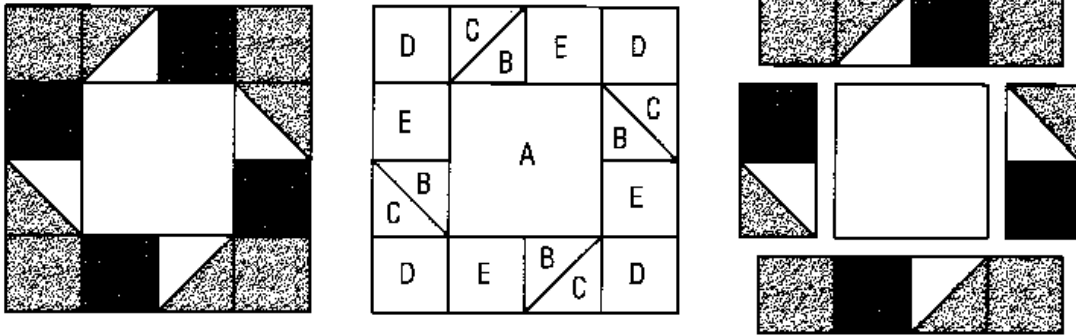


July Block of the Month

Paper Pinwheels for NSQ

Block size finished: 12" square



All measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.

Kit contains:

- A: 1 - 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square
- B: 2 - 4" squares
- C: 2 - 4" squares
- D: 4 - 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares
- E: 4 - 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

*Please measure the squares so as to use the right block in the right place. I plan to make this with lots of different colored pinwheels.

Directions:

First you will make 4 - half-square triangle squares using the B and C squares. Place the B-square on top of the C-square; draw a line (cutting line) on the diagonal. Then draw a line (sewing lines) $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side from the first. After sewing on the lines, cut apart and press toward the dark. Take to cutting mat and trim squares down to 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Now you are ready to lie out all the pieces as shown above. Sew half-square triangle square to an E square, these will measure 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ ", so they can be sewn to the center square, press toward the center. Now center will be 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ ", ready for finish. Sew the top and bottom pieces together, press toward the outside squares. They will measure each 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ ", now your ready to sew the top and bottom onto the center section. Press and measure the completed block as it should be 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Congratulations on a job well done and see you next month. **THANK YOU!!!**
