

NORTH STAR GUILD MEETING 06/16/11

There is some question if the ironing board rep will be able to attend. Martha and Jan will do quilts for kids. Demonstrations will be: Leslie Binding, Judy??, Arlene rug hooking and Gloria ???. Kathi will do quilt signs on Friday. Kathi and Mary Ann will do ribbons. Joyce's husband, Dick and Leslie's husband Van will be in charge of quilt racks. Judy Murdock will do door prizes. Sue will do raffle quilt ticket sales and help with door prizes.

It was reported that the quilt racks loaned to Big Rapids came back and they were not in order as they had been when they picked them up. It was decided that we will no longer loan the racks to the Big Rapids group.

Kathi reported that she contacted the Hospital and Eagle Village and the quilts are being handed out. The Village is in need of some more.

Joanne handed out the block of the month. Arlene showed some samples of string quilts.

Kathi made a motion to have Leslie purchase a roll of batting. Because of the rising cost of cotton Terry amended the motion to purchase 2 rolls of batting. Martha seconded. Motion passed.

Arlene and Elsie will make a list of special show and tell projects for the coming year.

Leslie made a motion to close the meeting and Nancy seconded. Motion passed.
