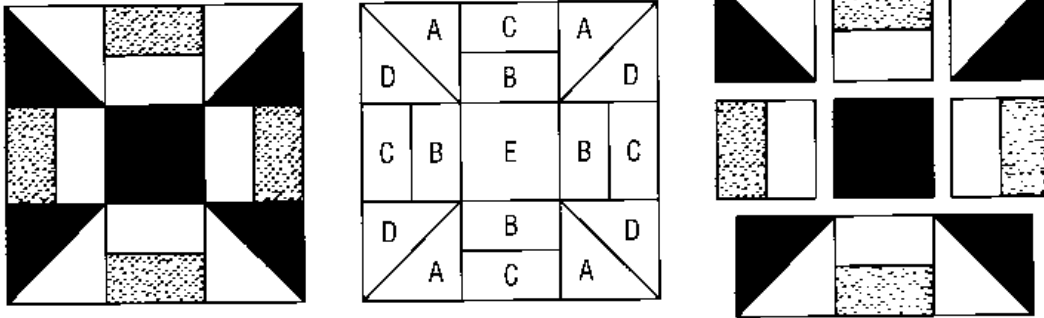


## May Block of the Month

### Farm Friendliness for NSQ

Block size finished: 12" square



All measurements include  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.

Kit contains:

A: 2 - 5" squares

B: 1 - 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " w strip = 4 - 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles

C: 1 - 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " w strip = 4 - 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles

D: 2 - 5" squares

E: 1 - 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " square

\*Please check the measurements of the squares so as to use the right ones in the right place.

Directions:

Sew the 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " w strips together and press toward the dark. They will measure 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " wide and you will now cut 4-4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares from the strip. Make half-square triangle squares using the A squares and the D squares, by drawing the lines on the back of the lighter color. Once the half-square triangle squares are made you will press toward the dark. Now trim down to 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " square each, lie out all the pieces as shown above for block assembly. Each row will measure 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12  $\frac{1}{2}$ ", when sewn together. Now sew the rows together and press. Block will measure 12  $\frac{1}{2}$ " square and ready to go with all the others for a quilt top. Congratulations, you've finished the May block, see you next month. THANK YOU!!!!
