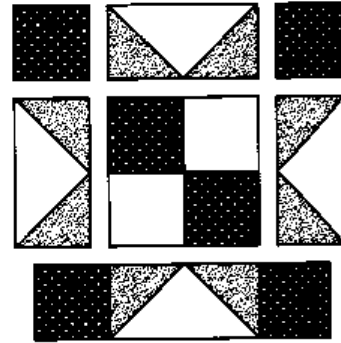
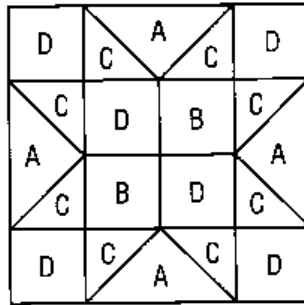
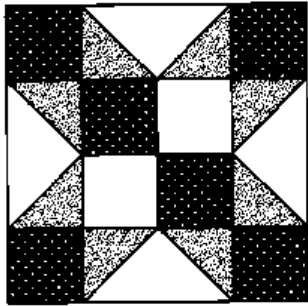


October Block of the Month

Indian Star for NSQ

Block size finished: 12" square



All measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.

Kit contains:

A: 1 - $7\frac{1}{4}$ " square (cut twice on the diagonal)

B: 2 - $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

C: 4 - $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares (cut once on the diagonal)

D: 6 - $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

* take time to measure the squares so as to know where to use them as I'm going to reverse the mediums and darks in every other block.

Directions:

First you will cut the A-square twice on the diagonal to make 4-triangles. Then you will cut the C-squares once on the diagonal to make 8-triangles for star points (as shown above). Now sew the C-triangles to the A-triangles and press toward the dark. Once you have all 4 units made, they will measure $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ "; you will lay the block out for sewing together (as shown above). Sew together the 4-patch center (should measure $6\frac{1}{2}$ " square), and add a star-point unit to each side. Now unit will measure $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ ". Then add the D-squares to the outside of 2 of the star-point units (they will measure $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " each) and add them to the other sides. Now measure your block as it should now measure $12\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Congratulations you've completed your block for the month of October. Now put it into the bag to return for next month.
