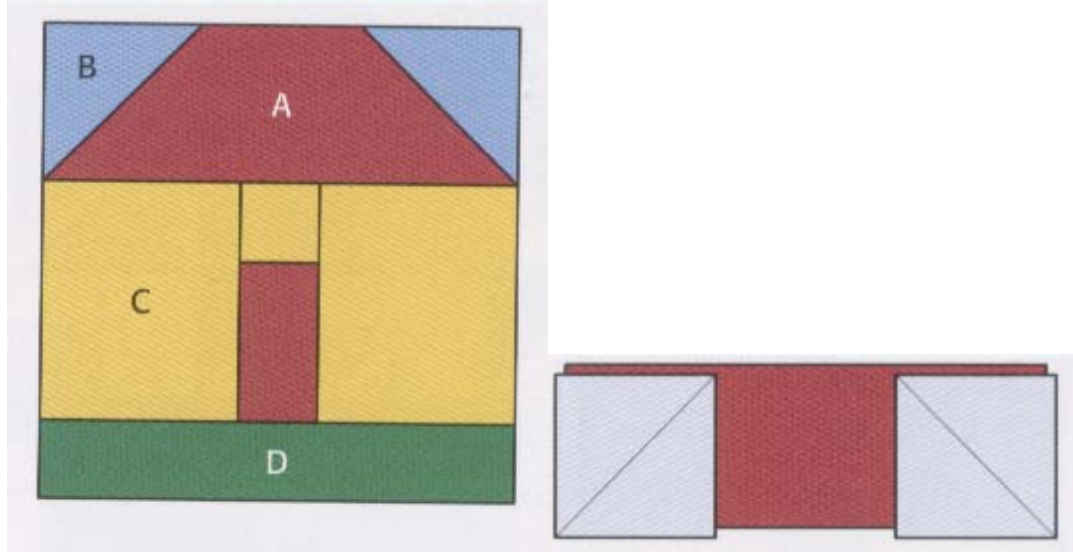


November Block of the Month 2008 House for NSQ

Finished block size: 12" square



All measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.

Kit contains:

Fabric	Cut size	No. needed
A - roof	4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ "	1
A - door	2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ "	1
B - blues	4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ "	2
C - house	5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ "	2
C - house	2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ "	1
*D - greens or leaf print	2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ "	1

Please measure all pieces, so as to use the right piece in the right place.

Sewing directions:

1. On the wrong side of B - 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares, draw one line diagonally. Position the B-square on each end of the A - 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle, (see fig. 1) to make sure the lines are running in the right direction. Sew on the diagonal lines and cut $\frac{1}{4}$ " from sewn lines and press toward the A fabric. Roof unit is done, it will measure 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ ", set aside.
2. Sew the C - 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square to one end of the A - 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle, and press toward the C fabric (door piece). Now sew a C - 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " to each long side of the door piece before. Press away from center. House unit will measure 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ ", is now ready to be sewn to the roof unit. Then sew D - 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle to the bottom, and press down toward D fabric. House block is now complete and will measure 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square unfinished. Bring it back next month with the baggie. Thank you!!!

*Variation: D - 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle can be cut from sky or background fabric instead of the green for grass as I have done above. Have fun!!
